

# **ARREST:** Held on \$350,000 in bonds

DePastino's probation officer charged him with violation of a protective order.

He was arraigned in Waterbury Superior Court Friday morning and is being held on

bonds totaling \$350,000.

Stephens said this is the second time DePastino has been arrested since he was released from prison. In 2010, he was charged with violation of probation when he visited a park and a ball field in Meriden.

The original crime which DePastino served prison sentence involved counts of first-degree sex assault.

He was convicted of rap a 3-year-old and an 18-month old girl in Southington.
