

# FACEBOOK: Accused angry over ex's conduct

Crude captions that referred to the woman as a "ho" were also posted with the pictures, according to Meade's arrest warrant.

Meade, 30, of 222 Wall St., was charged with fifth-degree computer crime after he admitted to Detective Peter Morgan that he had posted the sex pictures on the Facebook account of the 27-year-old woman, according to his arrest warrant.

The couple dated for a while and the woman eventually moved in with Meade. The couple also has a young son together, according to the warrant.

Meade told police he learned that the woman had cheated on him and their relationship ended in January with her moving out. Meade said he saw that his ex had posted photos online of her new boyfriend posing with Meade's son.

"I was angry that she would do this," Meade told Morgan, according to the warrant. "I felt that she was throwing it in my

face that she was having this guy around my son when I didn't want him to be."

Meade told Morgan he wanted to make her just as upset as he was. Meade found that the woman had left her Facebook password on his computer and he told police he logged on to her account.

Several pictures, including at least one explicit photo of the couple having sex, were posted to her account in June, according to the warrant. The woman learned of the posts after friends contacted her, according to court documents.

The woman was eventually able to regain control of her account and delete the pictures.

Facebook didn't respond to a request for a comment on what its users can do when they suspect their accounts have been hijacked.

Meade, who works in a restaurant, was released on a promise to appear in court next month. The computer crime he faces is a misdemeanor.
